

Declaration of Climate Emergency By Council

Motion Adopted by Council:

- Noting the latest IPPC report on climate breakdown
- Agreeing that drastic and far reaching measures required across society
- Declaring a 'Climate Emergency'
- Taking urgent measures to tackle Council's own impact upon greenhouse gas emissions
- Elevating the significance of the climate emergency across the local community and businesses
- Formulating a climate adaptation plan


