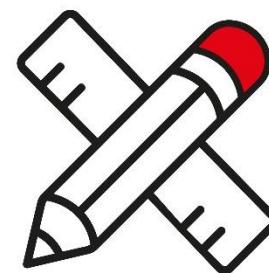
# Priority 1 - economic recovery from Covid-19

An ambitious economic vision that addresses the short-term impacts of Covid, but also the long-term challenges in skills, productivity and infrastructure

# Priority 3 – health and social care

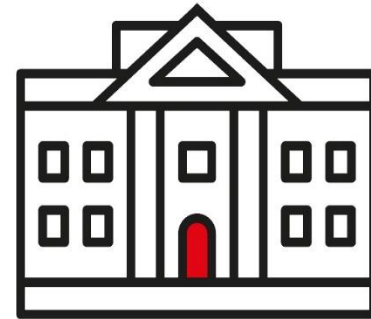
